Assemblage...past meets present

Philip Grant was born in 1963 in Glasgow Scotland. His family immigrated to Canada in 1966 and settled in Hamilton area in the 1970's. After attending Fanshawe College, and the University of Windsor and living in Toronto, Philip returned to his hometown in 1991 where he opened two galleries, exhibiting local emerging artists as well as his own work.

Philip's preferred medium is encaustic painting, a formula of bees-wax and pigment; he is well known for his encaustic landscapes, but more recently has also been creating abstracts, collages and portraits. This exhibit features both fresh paintings and some of his earlier works. Philip also makes box sculptures using found objects.

Today Philip lives and works in downtown Hamilton and has had solo and group shows at many venues over the past 25 years in regional galleries, private galleries and alternative venues such as shops, cafes and pubs, house shows and here at the Cathedral.
