7. Join us Easter day for one service at 10:30 a.m.

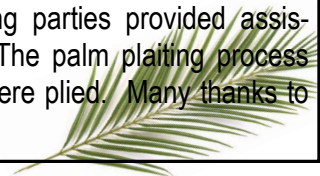


Around the Bay for Cathedral Choral Scholarships!

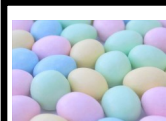
